Basilica di San Marco

Venice's most important church with rich history, grand architecture and precious art

Burano Island

Island on the Venetian Lagoon famous for its brightly colored and cheerful looking homes

Ca' Pesaro

Grand palace by Longhena houses Museum of Modern Art and Oriental Museum

Ca' Rezzonico

This beautiful palace houses a museum of 18th century Venice

Ca' d'Oro

The Golden House, 1413 is a restored palace with mosaics and fine architectural

Campanile di San Marco

See the 9th century bell tower of basilica di San Marco

Canal Grande

The main canal of Venice lined with historic buildings

Collezione Peggy Guggenheim

A modern art museum in an 18th century palace displaying masterpieces

Galleria dell'Accademia

Pre-18th century art including de Vinci, Carpaccio, Bellini, Guardi and Titian

Gondola Ride

Travel down the Grand Canal in a traditional gondola

I Gesuati

An 18th century baroque church with Rococo décor and Tiepolo frescoes

II Ghetto

Former 16th century Jewish ghetto, one of the first in the world

II Redentore

On Giudecca Island the temple-looking church has white stucco interior

Murano Island

Island on the Venetian Lagoon famous for its glass products

Museo Correr

Opuent former Venetian French Royal Palace houses Venice art and history museum

Museo Ebraico

The Jewish Museum displays artifacts of Venice Jewish history and culture

Palazzo Ducale

The Doge's Palace was once home to the rulers of Venice

Ponte dei Sospiri

The Bridge of Sighs arches over between Doge's Palace and the Old Prison

Ponte di Rialto

The beautiful covered Rialto Bridge is the oldest to cross the grand Canal

Riva degli Schiavoni

A 9th century waterway promenade lined with market stalls

SS. Giovanni e Paolo

Italian Gothic Church of St. John and Paul is large and impressive

San Giorgio Maggiore

Monastery on Cipressi Island, with beautiful art and tower with observation deck

San Salvador

A church with Cappelli frescoes, Novello mosaics and a magnificent floor

San Sebastiano

A modest exterior hides paintings by Veronese, Tintoretto and Titian

San Zaccaria

An historic church with art by Bellini, Trevisani, Van Dyck and Tiepolo

Santa Maria Gloriosa dei Frari

A 1338 church with rare rood screen, art by Titian, Bellini and Canova

Dogana da Mar

Former 17th century customs house now contemporary art museum

Piazza San Marco

Venice's most important square with a rich history and exquisite buildings

Santa Maria dei Miracoli

A miraculous Renaissance church, 1489 in the Jewish Quarter
